

ABOUT THE PROJECT

(SCHOOL) GREEN DAY



Once a year, we encourage schools in Brunei to dedicate a day in their school calendar to learn about environmental conservation.

We call it the School's Green Day.

VISION

Our vision is to help *Develop Brunei's Sustainable Generation* - one that is more informed and responsible which will lead the generation before and after them, with a sense of purpose and urgency towards solving the planet's most pressing problem.

Goals

- To reach out to 30 Schools, Higher Institutions and Universities in 2023.
- To educate 3,000 Students on Sustainability Mindset.
- To give birth to Brunei's Green Warriors community, a cohort of young eco-changemakers that will positively impact our environment.

Target Audience

This program is designed specifically for high school and tertiary students.

We target the more mature age group so that they will be in a better position to lead their school communities and convince their family and friends to change with the lessons learned from the training.

We aim to conduct a class for 100 students per school at each session.

Course Details

Full Day: (6 hours)

- Morning - Fundamental Knowledge
- Afternoon - Practical Skills

We want students to be inspired by the endless creativity and ideas that the world has to offer in solving climate change problems by showing them case studies of small practical solutions and big ideas that are changing the world.

Action

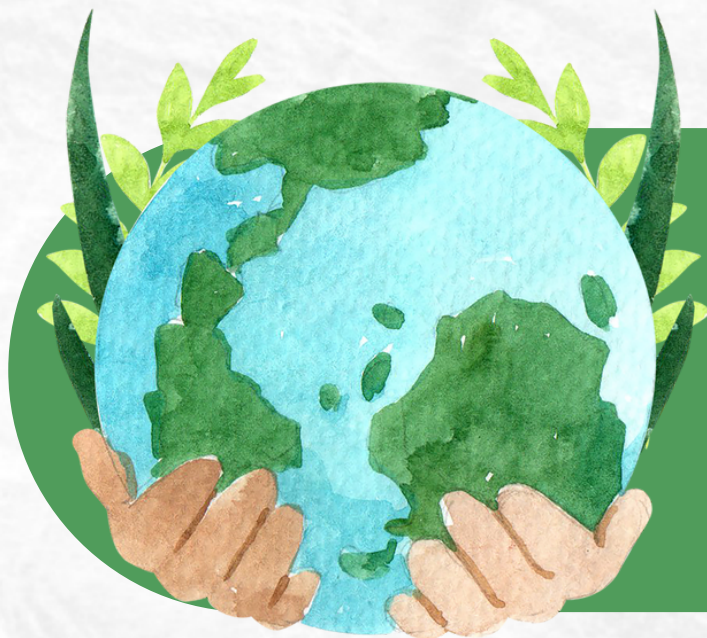
We want students to be able to take practical actions at home by recycling and repurposing their waste; and by applying the skills taught at the workshops.

Sustainable Action Pledges

How do we ensure that the Green Day project is not a one-off program, but the beginning of a green movement for the school and community?

- A key session in the program is a topic called **Sustainability Action Pledges** where students are assigned into groups to identify the key areas that they can change, make an impact and be more sustainable within their Community, School and their Homes.
- In the post program, we will help to facilitate and turn those ideas into actionable items which will make a difference.

Building a Community

- We will be forming a nationwide eco-system called **Brunei's Green Warriors** that will connect 5 student councils from each school to exchange ideas, create community projects and support each other's initiative.

Starting a Movement

- We will guide the Brunei Green Warriors to form a calendar of events to carry out periodic sustainable activities in schools.
